Jurisdiction: Held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Standing Grass Track Regulations of the A.C.U., the ACU Championship Conditions and these Supplementary Regulations.

Child Protection: The Secretary of the Meeting is the point of contact (National Sporting Code 6.16)

Eligibility: Open to all drivers and passengers in possession of a valid current ACU Competition Licence. First come, first served.

Entries: The insurance cover is by ACU Premier.

Entry Fee: Youth - £30, Quad - £37, Solo - £37, Sidecar - £47

(Includes free admittance for Competitors plus One Mechanic per entry only)

Course: To be approximately 450m. Racing direction: Solo, 500cc Sidecar, Left Hand Sidecar & Quads – Anti-clockwise, Right-Hand Sidecar & Clubman Sidecar – Clockwise.

Start Method: Off track

Practice: Minimum 2 laps – To go out in Programme Order

Legs: 4 laps, Finals: 4 laps.

Events 1-4 Youth: Trophies only

Events 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11 & 15 - Clubman Sidecar, GT140, 250cc Solo, 350cc Solo, Upright Solo, Unlimited Solo & Quad - £75, £50, £25.

Events 9, 12, 13 & 14- 500cc Solo, 500cc Sidecar, Left Hand Sidecar & Right Hand Sidecar -£100, £75, £50.

Format

Events 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 & 13 will have four point-scoring legs. **Event 5** will be competed over three legs and a final. The top six Sidecars qualify for the final. **Event 11** has two qualifying heats with the top four from each handicap heat progressing to the handicap final and is open to the 250cc, 350cc, 500cc & Upright Solo classes. **Event 14** is over three legs. With the top five point-scorers going straight to the A Final and six to eleventh position to the B Final where the winner will be promoted to the A Final. **Event 15** is over three legs, top six qualify for the A Final and positions seven to twelve compete in the B Final.

The winners of the Left Hand Sidecar win the Hilton Woodrow Trophy.

Points System: Solo: 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

Sidecar & Quad: 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

Ties: 1) Count back, 2) Best position in last heat where the riders met, 3) Last race, 4) Fastest race time

General: The club reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any/all events should circumstances warrant it or to change the race format should entry numbers differ.

No riding of machines in the pit area.

It is the competitor's responsibility to make sure they are in the pit box in time for their race.

Medication: It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs, you may be tested.

Having entered the event, if you become a Non-Starter, you must explain your absence to the promoting club. Failure to do so is a breach of the rules.

Refunds can be issued upon the receipt of a doctor's note.
